What is the concept of this collection?

This collection pays tribute to the beauty and tranquility of Japanese gardens. Each pen in the «Kyoto Garden» collection corresponds to a key element of Japanese gardens.

The first two pens in the collection represented:

- for the «Koke»: the moss that covers and carpets the rocks
- for the «Suikyou»: the «water mirror» found in the ponds of Japanese gardens

What do «Nishiki Goi» and «Icho» mean?

The «Nishiki Goi» is the term for ornamental koi fish, known for their striking colors and elegance.

The «Icho» pen refers to the Ginkgo biloba tree, famous for its fan-shaped leaves and golden-yellow color in autumn.
